# What is the Annual Performance Report (APR)?

LondonCityAirport

- A comprehensive report to document and record annually LCY's activities in relation to the planning consent
- Came about as a result of the 2009 Section 106 **Planning Agreement** between LCY and LBN
- Submitted to LBN on 1 July each year, reporting on previous calendar year (Jan – Dec)



# What is the APR?

- Published on LCACC website  
31 July each year
- Structure
  - 35 page main report
  - 20 Appendices over 335 pages  
and Glossary

# Contents of the APR

- The **Planning Agreement** provides the long-term framework for the Airport to use its planning permission sustainably and covers (but not limited to):
  - Operating Hours
  - Numbers and types of permitted aircraft movements
  - Noise monitoring and mitigating programmes
  - Air quality monitoring and mitigation programme
  - Sustainability and environmental strategies
  - Transport and Surface Access
  - Education, employment and training programmes
  - Financial contributions to infrastructure projects and local community initiatives

# Aircraft Movements

67,871 total aircraft movements  
in 2010  
-a decline of 10% over 2009

Types of aircraft that operated:

- 33% Avro RJ/BAe 146
- 19% Fokker 50
- 7.5% Dornier 328
- 19% Embraer 170 and 190
- 1.5% Airbus 318 (New York service)

**Appendix 4** – presents noise contour maps. These are primarily to determine eligibility boundaries for the sound insulation scheme:

- Includes report on ground running of aircraft engines

# Periodic Studies

## **Appendix 11 – Ground Noise Study**

- Undertaken every 3 years
- Measures noise from aircraft operations on the ground

## **Appendix 12 – Camel Road Sound Screen Study Report**

- One off study
- ascertains whether any improvements to screen need to be made
- In future, this assessment will be incorporated in the Ground Noise Study.



# Air Quality 1

- **Appendix 13 - Air Quality Measurement Programme 2010 Annual Report**
  - Monitoring carried out at two stations one on roof of City Aviation House and one at Newham Dockside in addition to diffusion tubes located in and around the airport
  - No recorded exceedences of statutory air quality objectives set by Government for nitrogen dioxide and fine particulate matter



# Air Quality 2 – One Off Studies

- **Appendix 14** - Individual Aircraft Types Study – looked at effects of individual aircraft types on air quality
- **Appendix 15** – Volatile Organic Compounds Study – looked at ‘airport odours’



# Education & Training

- **Primary Education**
  - 10 local schools benefitted in 2010 from the LCY Barnaby Bear geography programme for Year Two students
- **Secondary Education**
  - Offered the new business related education programme
  - Plane Business - for Year Nine students – to 4 schools
- **Higher Education**
  - 3 students supported by the LCY University Prize Scheme
- **Training**
  - 'City Interview' programme offered to NEETs
- **Work Experience**
  - To 44 local students per year



# Local Employment

## Dec 2010 Statistics

- 51 employers operating on LCY site
- 1,891 people employed on LCY site
- LCA Ltd – largest employer with 525 employees
- 27% of employees live in Newham
- 63% of employees live in Local Area (11 east London boroughs)



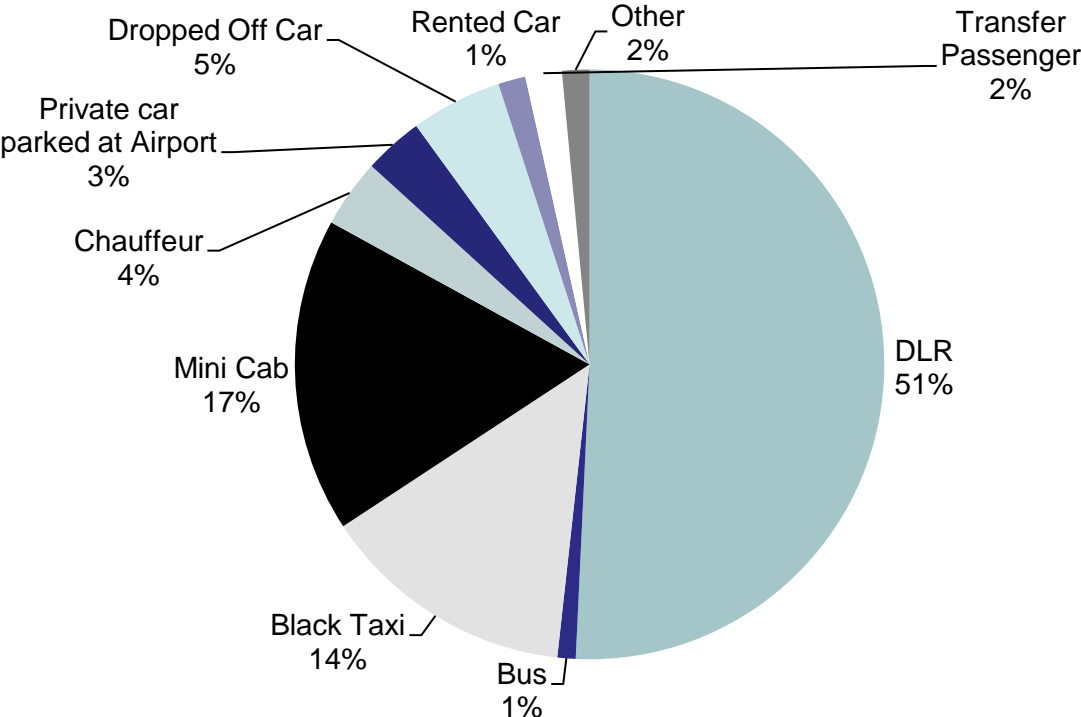
# Local Employment

# Surface Access 2010

## 2010 Last Mode of Transport



- 66% public transport share (DLR/Bus/Black Cab)
- LCY Travel Plan to encourage passengers and staff to use public transport

# Environmental Complaints/Enquiries

LondonCityAirport

- 55 complaints
  - 36 related to aircraft noise
  - 5 related to flight paths
  - 6 related to ground noise
  - 8 related to a mix of other matters
- 39 environmental enquiries
- 13 complaints/enquiries – regarding aircraft operating to/from other airports
- All complaints investigated and reported to LBN
- Quarterly report provided to LCACC



# Financial Contributions

- During 2010, LCA Ltd paid c £0.36m to London Borough of Newham:
  - £207,000 for Community Projects
  - £84,000 for Education & Training Initiatives
  - £75,000 for Airport Monitoring Payment
