Draft Noise Action Plan

What is it about?

The Noise Action Plan has been drafted to manage the issues of noise arising from London City Airport's operations over the next five years. The plan has been drafted in response to a directive published by the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs which requires airport operators to prepare draft plans designed to manage noise issues.

When is it happening?

The airport's 16 week public consultation runs until 15 January 2010. During the consultation period, local communities, councils and other stakeholders are invited to comment on the airport's draft plan.
